

KINROSS-SHIRE CIVIC TRUST
ARCHITECTURE AWARD SCHEME 2016

Conditions of Entry

1. Entries must be submitted by the architect.
2. The client must approve the entry.
3. All building works for consideration must have been carried out and completed between 2010 and January 2016.
4. Any new building may be entered, whether for private, public or commercial use.
5. A brief outline of the scheme should be attached to the application, together with a floor plan of the building and photographs. Electronic plans are welcomed providing they reproduce satisfactorily at A4 size.
6. The judges will inspect all the sites and assess the building both internally and externally and will consider the following points:-
 - a. The general standard of design and its impact on the surrounding area
 - b. The standard of construction and finish
 - c. The extent to which the project employs innovation and initiative in order to achieve the desired result.
7. The assessors' decision will be final.
8. The Award results will be announced at an Awards ceremony and provided to the local press.
9. The Award will take the form of a plaque for display at the winning scheme. Certificates will be presented to the architect, builder and commissioning client of the winning scheme.
